
SPEED LIMIT (TEMPORARY ROAD CONSTRUCTION) REGULATIONS

G.N. 75/1963

(SECTION 43(2))

[Commencement 30th March, 1963]

Citation.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Speed Limit (Temporary Road Construction) Regulations.

Speed limit.

2. (1) Notwithstanding the provisions relating to speed limits contained in the Motor Vehicle and Speed Limit Regulations, the speed limit for all motor vehicles, over those portions of road under construction or repair by the Bahamas Construction Equipment Limited (hereinafter referred to as “the Company”) and for a distance of one thousand feet in either direction of the said portions of road, shall be ten miles per hour.

(2) The Controller of Road Traffic shall cause to be placed at appropriate points along roads under construction or repair by the Company traffic signs indicating the speed limit imposed by paragraph (1) of this regulation.

Duration.

3. The provisions of regulation 2 of these Regulations shall remain in force so long as the Company shall be engaged in constructing or repairing roads in New Providence as aforesaid.

Citation.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Road Traffic and Speed Limit (Cat Island) Regulations.

Interpretation.

2. In these Regulations, unless the context otherwise requires —

“Controller” means the Commissioner for the district of Arthur’s Town and the district of The Bight in the Island of Cat Island;
